Dear Neighbour,

We wrote to you back in May informing you that we were due to commence connection works to the foul and storm water inspection chambers on Lower Oldfield, for a few days in June. These works were postponed as Wessex Water and the BANES Highway department required further information from ourselves prior to allowing these works to commence. Both Wessex Water and BANES Highways are now satisfied with our proposals and we therefore intend to commence these works from tomorrow.

In order to carry out the works safely and avoid closing the road, it will be necessary to prevent parking to the spaces immediately outside some of your homes. The work will be carried out in two phases as there are two separate inspection chambers to connect into. The first phase will commence tomorrow for a period of 3 days. It will be necessary to cordon off the spaces before close of business today and they will be available again by Thursday evening of this week.

Phase 2 will commence on Monday 26th July and will again take 3 days to complete.

Enclosed is a plan of areas effected by these works.
