RE: Mock Exam Week Study Leave and Further Information

As you will be aware, next week is the Mock Exam week at Hayesfield School. Your daughter has already submitted to me a Study Plan and this along with her attendance rate for this year has provided me with the information I need to decide whether or not Study Leave should be granted. Your daughter has already been informed of this decision.

If your daughter has been granted Study Leave then she is not expected in school at any time when she is not in an examination.
