### Year 7 Setting Information - September 2011

Your daughter has been given her new timetable which shows which classes she is in this year. This letter is intended to clarify what some of the codes on that timetable mean, and to allow you to see how the students have been grouped.

Students have been placed in ability sets for many subjects, based on their KS2 SATs results; KS2 Teacher assessed levels and CATS scores. The number next to the subject code on the timetable tells you which set your daughter is in (1 is the highest set). So your daughter will be in classes with students who have similar ability to her.

To boost their skills, some students have literacy lessons instead of studying Spanish. Students are in mixed ability tutor groups for registration with their Tutor, and will be taught in these groups for Art, Drama, PE, PSHEE (Personal, Social, Health and Economic Education), RS and Technology.
