

A LEVEL ART AND DESIGN -PHOTOGRAPHY

We currently follow the AQA syllabus for the Photography endorsement of the Art and Design GCE AS and A2 syllabus.

This course allows you to explore and develop your own creative ideas, learn relevant technical language and explore the history of Photography, and research the work of contemporary photographers.

The approach is very similar as in Art except your final pieces will be photographs, (film or digital, stills or film / video) of some kind but the same format of working through a sketchbook and getting marks for observation, experimentation, research, development and final pieces is the same.

To find out if this course is suitable for you answer these questions

Do you really enjoy Photography and Art and are you really interested in all different types of visual culture?

Can you put together an exciting sketchbook to show off your ideas?

Can you research artists and photographers and write a 3000 word essay about what you discover?

Can you get yourself a SLR camera – digital or film

Are you predicted to get at least a grade B in G.C.S.E ART?

Can you put a lot of effort into a unique summer project to secure a place on the course?

Can you work independently to develop ideas with support but without always being told what to do?

Can you spend at least 5 hours a week on homework - most of the work happens outside lesson time.
