Standards Policy - Expectations

Principles

- to achieve a safe, efficient, calm, purposeful atmosphere throughout the school, so that all students can take advantage of and benefit from being here
- to enable students to develop self-respect
- to encourage students to take a pride in their work and behaviour and appreciate their own success
- to promote mutual respect and politeness between staff and students

Objectives

Students will be expected to wear school dress as listed in the student planner, at all times, unless exceptions are made for specific occasions.

Students will be asked to provide the basic equipment as listed in the student planner; and bring this to all lessons.

Students will be expected to take a pride in their work and to present it in a neat manner, and meet the demands of each subject as requested, to the best of their ability.

Homework is important, and must be completed and handed in on time.

Lessons will begin and end in a formal and organised manner. Students in the Lower School will be expected to stand and wait silently for staff directions.

A quiet, calm atmosphere will be maintained throughout the lesson, with students expected to exercise self-control in order to allow all to benefit from the experience.

Students will move about the school in a sensible and controlled manner.

Students must accept that certain actions, such as chewing during lessons and/or registration, give offence and are not acceptable.

Good behaviour will be recognised, but students must understand and accept that if they do not meet these standards, sanctions will be necessary.
